Half-day Hong Kong City Tour - 9:30 am - 1:30 pm (4 hrs.)

Today, we enjoy a half-day tour of Hong Kong City, starting with Victoria Peak, the highest hill on Hong Kong Island, where we can enjoy spectacular views of the bay and surrounding cityscape. As one of the ritziest residential areas in Hong Kong, you may also catch a glimpse of some lavish homes. We go from there to Repulse Bay, one of the prettiest areas in Hong Kong, with an enchanting beach, pricey housing, and the distinctive Repulse Bay Building. Then we take a walk through the Aberdeen Fishing Village, past little docks and hundreds of houseboats, fishing junks, and sampans. For additional cost, you can enjoy a ride in a traditional Sampan Boat around the harbor area, taking in seaside views of the Fishing Village.

Hong Kong - Kowloon - Hong Kong Breakfast

Kowloon Chi Lin Nunnery - Nan Lian Garden / Ladies Street Market

Half-day Kowloon Tour - 9:30 am - 1:30 pm (4 hrs.)

Today, we head over to Kowloon, where we begin our half-day tour with a visit to the <u>Chi Lin Nunnery</u> – an idyllic retreat for Buddhist nuns built in the Tang Chinese style, featuring statues of Buddhas and bodhisattvas. Next to the <u>Nunnery is Nan Lian</u> <u>Garden</u>, which attempts to create the concept of a Buddhist paradise, and is centered around the gold-colored Pavilion of Absolute Perfection. We go from there to the <u>Ladies Street Market</u>, which features shops specializing in women's fashions, accessories, and cosmetics. After, we return to the hotel in Hong Kong City.

Hong Kong – Macau Breakfast / Dinner

Macau [St. Paul's Cathedral Ruins, Senado Square, Drive through Cotai Strip to see the Hotels and Casinos]

Pick up and Transfer to Hong Kong pier and ferry to Macau (1 hr. ride). Meet local guide after clearing immigration then Macau City tour approximately 4 hours.

Our first stop in Macau is the Ruins of St. Paul's <u>Cathedral</u>. The cathedral was originally built by Japanese Christian craftsmen who escaped Hideyoshi's persecution. After the cathedral was destroyed in a fire in 1835, all that remains is the impressive front façade, which contains intricate carvings related to the Assumption of Mary. We go from there to Senado Square, a European-style city square with Western architecture surrounding a wave-patterned promenade with a large fountain at the center. After, we drive through Cotai Strip, which features many of the most important hotels and casinos central to Macao's gambling industry, including The Venetian Macau, The Plaza, The Londoner, and The Parisian.



Nagasaki Breakfast / Lunch

Nagasaki [Nagasaki Peace Park & Atomic Bomb Museum / Twenty-Six Martyrs Monument / Dejima / Oura Church / Glover Garden]

Today, we head to Nagasaki, first to visit the city's most important landmark: the Nagasaki Peace Park. Created in the aftermath of nuclear explosion during World War 2, the Nagasaki Peace Park features an inspirational Peace Statue, a Hypocenter Monument at the point of impact, the remains of the former Urakami Cathedral, and a collection of Peace memorials donated from countries around the world. Near the park is the Atomic Bomb Museum built in remembrance to the events and victims of the nuclear attack on the city during WW2, with sobering photos of the city's devastation and preserved accounts from the survivors. We go from there to the Twenty-Six Martyrs Monument, which remembers the lives and deaths of 26 Catholic martyrs who were executed in Nagasaki on the orders of Toyotomi Hideyoshi. We go from there to the man-made island of Dejima. Originally a Dutch trading station, it contained the only Westerners permitted in Japan during the Edo period. Many of its historic structures are of elegant European architecture, with refined interior décor. Then visit Oura Church, built at the end of the Edo period in 1864 by a French missionary. This is considered the oldest standing Christian church in Japan. At the end of the day, we stroll around Glover Garden, an open-air museum which includes a pretty flower garden, the old Glover Estate, and other Western-style residences and buildings. They depict the affluent lives of the wealthy foreign merchants who moved to the Japan after the country opened to foreign trade.

Nagasaki - Shimabara - Kumamoto - Beppu Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner

Shimabara [Japanese Candle Making & Painting Experience / Ferry from Shimabara to Kumamoto], Kumamoto [Kumamoto Castle / Suizenji Garden]

After breakfast, we depart for Shimabara, were we stop for a Japanese Candle-Making and Painting Experience. Learn how traditional Japanese candles are made out of natural materials, after which you can paint your candle as you like. We take the ferry from Shimabara to Kumamoto, to visit Kumamoto Castle. Kumamoto Castle is one of the top castles in Japan, and having recently been restored from the damage suffered during the 2016 Kumamoto earthquake, it now features an exhibition with displays about the castle's history. After, we visit Suizenii Garden, a charming Japanese landscape garden. As you walk the paths around the garden, you can see the 53 post stations of the old Tokaido Road represented in the garden's meticulously maintained scenery. After, we depart for the hot spring resort city of Beppu, where we check into the evening's accommodation.

Beppu - Fukuoka Breakfast / Lunch

Beppu [Beppu Hells - visit 3 hells / Steam Cooking Center / Beppu City Traditional Bamboo Crafts Center - Bamboo Bell Making Experience / Costco / Yatai Food Stalls - Dinner on own]

Today, we begin our tour of <u>Beppu</u> with a visit to three of the famed Beppu Hells - fantastic hot springs each known for their distinctive features, such as a red color or swirls on the surface. Please be aware that these hot springs are dangerously hot, and are intended for viewing rather than bathing. We go from there to the Steam Cooking Center, which uses the steam of the Hells to cook meat and vegetables. We then visit the Beppu City Traditional Bamboo Crafts Center, where you can see a wide variety of bamboo handicrafts on display, and participate in a Bamboo Bell Making Experience. Then we visit a local Costco, which has excellent deals on a variety of bulk items, including many items that are sold exclusively in Japan. We then head to the famous Yatai Food Stalls of Fukuoka, where you are free to roam around on your own and find a dinner to suit your taste.



Fukuoka [Hakata Doll Hall Shogetsudo with Hakata Doll Painting Experience], Yanagawa [Yanagawa Hina Matsuri Festival - Canal Punting]

After breakfast, we start the day at the <u>Hakata Doll</u> <u>Hall Shogetsudo</u>, enjoying a Hakata Doll-Painting Experience. Hakata Dolls are a type of unglazed clay Japanese doll with delicate, elegant features. Try your hand at painting one of these charming dolls.

We go from there to <u>Yanagawa</u>, where we arrive during the <u>Yanagawa Hina Matsuri Festival</u>. Take in a unique view of the city on a ride in a small boat and enjoy the picturesque scenery of the <u>Yanagawa</u> <u>Canals</u>. After, we return to Fukuoka.
